Setting Your Internet Home Page

Computers usually come with a predetermined Home page, usually the Home page of the manufacturer of your computer.






When you get connected to the Internet many times the Internet Service Provider (ISP) will change the Home page to their Home page. Many times you will get an email address along with that service. This does not mean that you must use it, if you already have an Internet email address you can continue to use it regardless of who your provider may be. A Home page can be your own website, a local newspaper website, a sports website, etc.

You can set your Home Page in the following ways:

If you are using Internet Explorer

-  Enter the website address on the address bar of your current Home page click Enter on the keyboard or click on Go or the arrow (depending on which version you have)
-  Click on Tools on the menu bar
-  Click on Internet Options
-  On the General Tab under Home Page, Click on Use Current
-  Click on OK

If you are using Mozilla Firefox

-  Enter the website address on the address bar of your current Home page click Enter on the keyboard or click on the arrow
-  Go to Tools on the menu bar
-  Click on Options
-  On the Main Tab > Click on Use Current Page
-  Click on OK
